#### Qualifications for Internal Scholarships

- Academic Programs: The GPA is based on the 10 best subject marks from Grades 11 & 12, but must include the 5 core subjects and 3 Gr. 12 Academic Post-secondary subjects (school mark) and then the best 2 Grade 11 and/or 12 subjects. The majority of your Gr. 12 courses must be taken at GFSS.
- Vocational Programs: The GPA is based on the 12 best subject marks but must include the 5 core subjects and 3 Grade 12 level subjects and the best 4 Grade 11 and/or 12 subjects. The majority of your Gr. 12 courses must be taken at GFSS. Youth in Trades programs will also be considered.

## External Scholarships

A number of these scholarships require transcripts. We will attach these to your forms prior to sending off the package.

# Auxiliary to the Christina Lake Community Association Scholarship

A sum of \$1000.00 to go to a student residing at Christina Lake and proceeding to a post-secondary institution or Trades program. Must have volunteer experience.

### Black Bettys Women's Hockey Bursary

This \$300.00 bursary is available to any graduating female student at GFSS who has been involved in Grand Forks Minor Hockey for a minimum of 3 years and is proceeding to any post-secondary institution.

#### **Border Bruins Memorial Award**

One \$300.00 award for a Border Bruin team member with good academic achievement as well as good community and team involvement. This bursary goes to a member of the local community.

# Boundary District Teacher's Association

A sum of \$4500.00 to be awarded to sons or daughters of BDTA members who are pursuing a career in education or child care work.

## Boundary Indigenous Education Council Bursary

Two bursaries of \$500.00 each awarded to students of Indigenous ancestry at GFSS. Preference will be given to those who have been actively involved in their school's Indigenous Program and/or with the Indigenous community. May submit a 250 word essay OR give a small presentation demonstrating their commitment to culture and community, as well as how they would apply the bursary to furthering their future education.

### Boundary Music Educators' Scholarship

This is a \$300.00 scholarship, established in 2010, that is awarded to a student that has studied music with a BMEA teacher and has volunteered in performance showcases within the community of Grand Forks. Priority to those accepted to a Music Program at a college or university level.

## Boundary Musical & Theatre Society Bursary

This bursary is awarded to a graduate who has demonstrated hard work, commitment, and dedication in a production by the Boundary Musical & Theatre Society.

## Boundary Women's Softball League Bursary

A bursary of \$250.00 to any graduating female student who has been actively involved in sports. Write a 500 word essay discussing how sports have benefitted you and how sports has affected your community.

#### Carpe Diem

Two to five scholarships of \$500.00-\$1000.00 each available to students at Grand Forks Secondary proceeding to any post secondary institution. Application must include a 500 word essay focusing on your "Greatest Passion" in life and how you plan to pursue this passion.

### Christina Lake Fire Department Bursary

\$500.00 to a son or daughter of a Christina Lake Fire Department member. No application necessary.

#### **C.U.P.E.** Local 2098

(Boundary Schools)

This \$500.00 bursary is open to any Grade 12 student who intends to pursue post-secondary education. Preference will be given to a son/daughter of a CUPE Local 2098 member

#### **C.U.P.E.** Local 2254

This is a \$500.00 bursary for a dependent of CUPE 2254 member who has a commitment to further his/her education and has a quality education plan and evidence of good citizenship including school and extra curricular activities.

# C.U.P.E. Local 4728 – City of Grand Forks

This is a \$1000.00 scholarship for each dependent of a CUPE 4728 member who has a commitment to further their education (no application necessary).

### District Authority Award

\$1250.00 to six students at GFSS going into any postsecondary program. Students must complete an outstanding project based on one of the following 7 areas: Fine Arts, Applied Design Skills & Technology, Indigenous Languages & Culture, Physical Activity, International Languages, Community Service (volunteer activities) and Technical & Trades Training and present this to the District Scholarship Committee on May 6<sup>th</sup>.

## Gordon and June Brox Memorial Scholarship

For a student who displays academic strengths, has clear goals/plans for their future, intends to go to university and is involved in the community.

## Gordon Keir Memorial Scholarship

A \$300.00 scholarship to be awarded to assist a student proceeding to post-secondary education. Preference given to a student who has been actively involved in community and/or school recreation.

# Grand Forks Choral Society Bursary

Up to three bursaries of \$250.00 to a student(s) pursuing post-secondary education who have been actively involved in the Grand Forks Choral Society productions.

### Grand Forks & District Fall Fair Scholarship

A \$500.00 scholarship available to any student wishing to attend a vocational or technical school in the areas of agriculture (farm studies, equipment) food programs, equine services, building trades, or the veterinary field. Preference will be given to a student who has participated in 4-H activities or has been active in volunteer work with the Fall Fair.

#### GFSS Gaming Fund Scholarship

Four scholarships of \$500.00 each that will be awarded to qualified students in the technical, vocational, academic and fine arts area of study. Need, special circumstances, volunteer service and individuals' specific goals are determining criteria. A short essay is required and special consideration if a parent or guardian has taken an active volunteer role on PAC or in our school community.

### Grand Forks Volunteer Firefighters Scholarship

\$750.00 to each deserving candidate who has demonstrated qualities of citizenship and who are sons or daughters of members or honorary members of the Grand Forks Fire Rescue Association. No application necessary.

## Grand Forks R.C.M.P. Terry Hamagami Memorial Scholarship

An undetermined amount as of today, will be awarded to students pursuing post-secondary education in either academic or vocational areas that provide beneficial social and/or public service to communities. Areas of studies for consideration include, but are not limited to: Social services, any profession dealing with the health of people and law enforcement.

Students must have a minimum C+/B average and be registered and accepted to a post-secondary facility within 12 months of graduation. Other qualifications which may be a factor in choosing the recipients are students who volunteer at the Hamagami Memorial Golf Tournament (May 3<sup>rd</sup>) or are active volunteers in the community.

### **Grand Forks Realty Bursary**

\$1000.00 available to a student at GFSS proceeding to any post-secondary institution. To be awarded to a candidate who has demonstrated a passion to further their education and become a professional in their chosen field.

#### John A. Robertson Memorial Scholarship

\$3200.00 will be awarded to the "Best All-Round Athlete" in the Grand Forks Secondary graduating class who will be pursuing post-secondary education (university, college or trades school). Applicant must submit an application along with a 400-500 word essay on what 'diversity' means to them.

## Patricia McNish & Roger Reams Scholarship

Approximately \$3300.00 to a student who is interested and accomplished in a field of music, preferably entering a music program. An interview will be required.

# Richard & Beverly Reid Young Artist's Scholarship
